

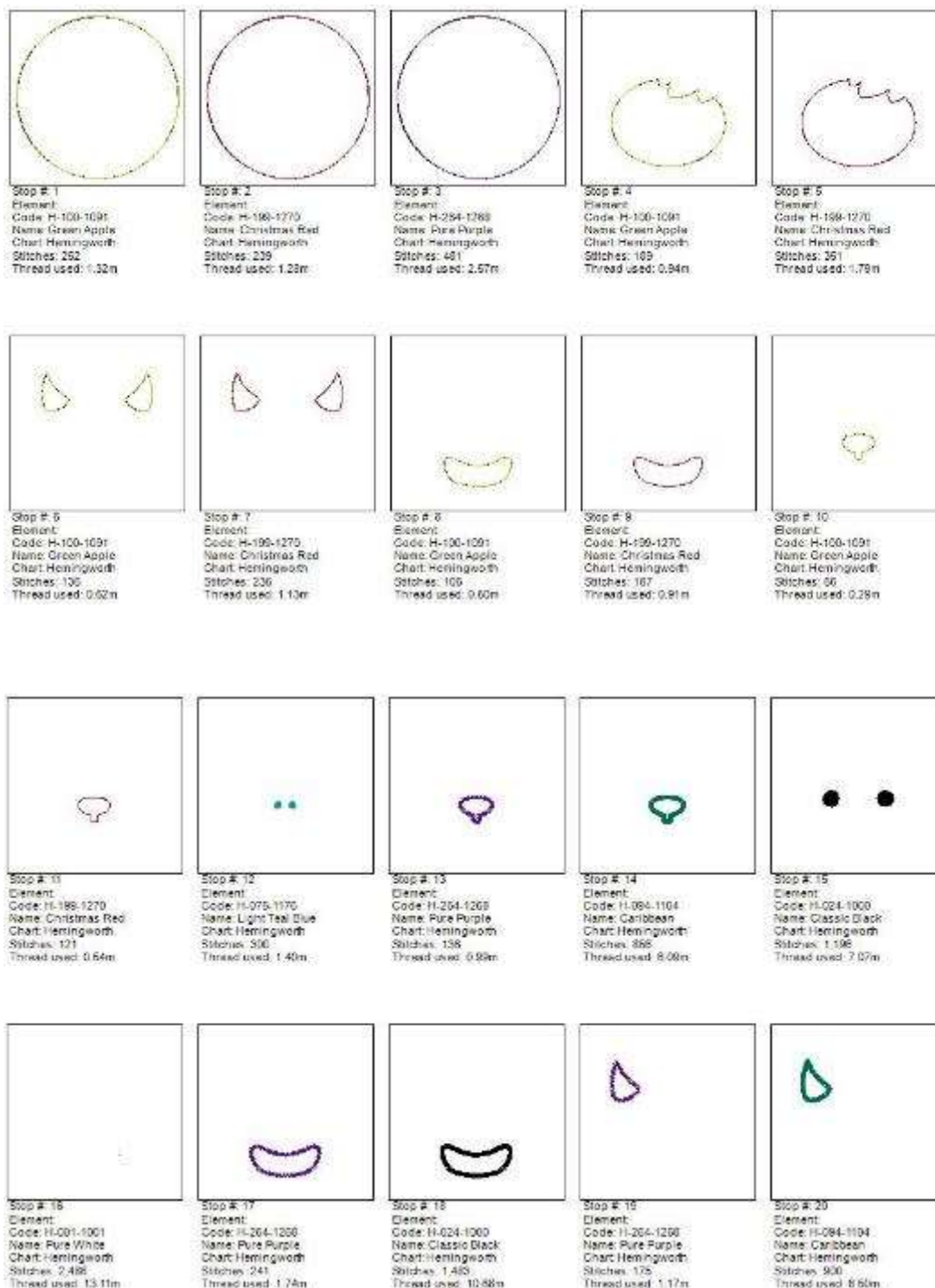

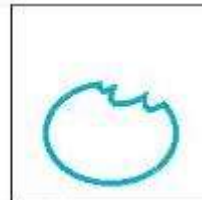

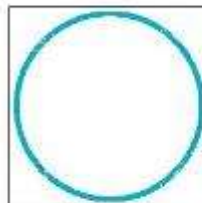

**Step 1.** Hoop your WSS stabiliser

**Step 2.** Stitch the placement line – **Stitch 1**

**Step 3.** Place your batting/pellon over the placement line and attach. - **Stitch 2**

**Step 4.** Trim your batting back to the placement line

**HINT: Trim the back tie off threads whenever you have to remove your hoop from your machine.**

**Step 5.** Place your Yeti head fabric over the batting and attach – **Stitch 3**



**Step 6.** Placement line for Yeti face – **Stitch 4**

✚ If your background fabric is going to show through, trim the inside away to expose the batting and place face fabric over batting only. Otherwise you can just continue.

**Step 7.** Lay your face fabric over the placement line and attach. - **Stitch 5**



- Step 8.** Placement line for ears fabric – **Stitch 6**
- Step 9.** Lay your ear fabric over placement lines and attach – **Stitch 7**
- Step 10.** Placement line for mouth – **Stitch 8**
- Step 11.** Lay your mouth fabric over placement lines and attach – **Stitch 9**
- Step 12.** Placement line for nose – **Stitch 10**
- Step 13.** Lay your nose fabric over placement line and attach - **Stitch 11**



- Step 14.** Next we add facial features.
- ✚ Nostrils – **Stitch 12**
  - ✚ Zig zag nose – **Stitch 13**
  - ✚ Satin stitch nose – **Stitch 14**
  - ✚ Black of eyes – **Stitch 15**
  - ✚ White of eyes – **Stitch 16**
  - ✚ Zig Zag mouth – **Stitch 17**
  - ✚ Satin stitch mouth – **Stitch 18**



**Step 15.** Zig zag left ear – **Stitch 19**

**Step 16.** Satin stitch left ear – **Stitch 20**

**Step 17.** Zig zag right ear – **Stitch 21**

**Step 18.** Satin Stitch left ear – **Stitch 22**

**Step 19.** Zig zag face – **Stitch 23**

**Step 20.** Satin stitch face – **Stitch 24**





**Step 21.** Remove hoop from machine and turn it over.

**Step 22.** Place ribbon for hanging (8"-9" folded in half) & backing fabric (wrong side facing hoop) over the top of the design ensuring it is all covered.

**Step 23.** To Attach backing and ribbon – Float, tape or pin your backing fabric to back of hoop and stitch to attach – **Stitch 25**



**Step 24.** Remove hoop from machine and carefully trim the excess fabric from front and back

**Step 25.** Return hoop to machine and zig zag outer edge – **Stitch 26**

**Step 26.** Satin stitch for around design edge. – **Stitch 27**

**Step 27.** We're all done! Carefully cut away excess stabiliser and then clean the edges.
